

Q: How did you end up venturing into the preschool

A: in the mid-Bit. I were running a bruit mess pulsarity and distributing educational books for children. In the process, I found out from parents about the lack of good preschools and kindergartens. In 2008, we set up a childcare contre dedicated solely for this CSP purpose. It's in a Hindu temple in Sengkang, It currently houses more than 30 children and it's kcensed for more than 60. Children from flower-income families pay highly subsidised sates to get a full-fledged Montesson education.
